Soror Frankie Mae Tarrance Gadson White was born on August 24, 1923 and died on February 19, 2009. Soror White was a member of Beta Alpha Chapter Detroit, Michigan. She was an alumni of Lewis College of Business and one of the original chartered member of Gamma Phi Delta Sorority, Inc. that signed and filed the Articles of Incorporation with the State of Michigan on July 9, 1943. She received her B.A. from Wayne State University and was employed by the U.S. Army for 38 years as a Procurement Manager.

She was very active with GPD until 2006 when she relocated to Georgia. She started in Alpha Chapter, Beta and her final chapter was Beta Alpha. She held numerous positions and she was the Basileus of Beta Chapter and the First Anti in Beta Alpha. Soror White was greatly involved in her church, Greater Grace Temple.
